Coronavirus/Covid-19

We will continue to closely monitor the situation regarding the worldwide coronavirus outbreak. I want to assure you that JACAD is following the latest Public Health England guidelines, and has read the government's new action plan for monitoring the outbreak. Dance World Cup

I am delighted to let you know that 41 of our company students have been selected to represent ENGLAND in the Dance World Cup in Rome, Italy. 62 countries will compete over the course of a week in the summer and will culminate with a Gala of gold medal winning performances! We as part of Team England will compete various group dances in Children/Junior/Senior Age groups in Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Contemporary and Song & Dance from Saturday 27th June through to Saturday 4th July 2020 — subject to the event not being cancelled due to Covid-19. This is a fabulous opportunity once again for company students and the school and I feel so proud that these are my pupils once again representing England! We are trying to do as much fundraising as possible — asking local firms for sponsorship, bag packing at local supermarkets, baking and selling cakes etc. With this in mind we have put together some fundraising ideas within the school for everyone to enjoy!

Show 2021

I know from many of you that you can't wait to see your children perform again on stage, so I am very excited to announce that the theatre is booked and production plans are in progress for our JACAD Show in Easter 2021. With the event a year away, we will reveal more over the next term or so including our working title. EVERY pupil attending class at JACAD will be invited to participate so make sure you have the dates in your diary NOW. This is something you will want your child to experience! Easter 2021 happens to be at the beginning of the holiday period, so everyone will still have their Easter break.

EASTER SHOW 29th March-4th April 2021

Rehearsals at South Hill Park - Monday 29th through to 1st April 2021

We are delighted to be using South Hill Park's Wilde Theatre once again for our Show. The theatre is extremely local and has all the latest technology to enable us to produce a great show. Rehearsals will take place during term time mostly during class times initially. The first week of OUR Easter Holiday (Mon 29th Mar—Thurs 1st April incl.) will be spent rehearsing at the theatre. Our performances are on Good Friday 2nd April, Sat 3rd April and Easter Sunday 4th April where we will have two performances per day (matinee and evening). I would suggest making a diary note that the Easter Weekend 2021 will be dedicated to these performances thus avoiding any potential clashes— i.e. holidays. Hopefully you will have plenty of notice to get all your family and friends together over Easter and see the show!

The format of our show will include every pupil at the school, by creating input from every class (excluding Ballet Majors, coaching, flexibility and conditioning classes), where we will work on performance dances. In addition to this there will be auditions and casting for specific roles for which there may be age and/or height restrictions—see audition date in the diary section. Audition packs will be available to those wishing to audition in November.

Syllabus work will continue initially in the Autumn Term and it is planned that show work and choreography will commence for some pupils after the October half term, and fully from December 2020. From my perspective It is a delight to see ALL the children perform in one production. For my younger pupils to interact with those who have been dancing for some time and working them together for a common goal is a particularly valuable and exciting experience for all. Very young children (under 5s) are only ever included in the first half, so that if they are too tired to stay for a full evening performance they can be collected from back-stage during the interval. More information will be given out over the next few terms to all parents to explain all about what is involved in participation.

There will be no additional rehearsals until March, where we will then use the weekends to pull full scenes together and some classes may join for extended lessons during the week days, it will reach a peak a couple of weeks before the show. At times the rehearsal schedule may look daunting to the under 5's, but please be assured this age group are accommodated in much smaller blocks of time than the older children, and we try and make the experience a great deal of fun for them.

I will say at this point to new parents (as existing parents know this very well) that the shows that JACAD put on are full productions and we are always extremely proud of the end performance. However it would not be possible without so many parents offering their help—and we will need you again! We do look for a great deal of parental support—sewing, scenery, backstage and chaperones to name but a few, and hopefully you will enjoy the process—it's great fun to be involved! For those who already have chaperone licenses, please make sure you renew them ASAP, and for those that don't we will advise what to do next term.

Notice Period

Just a reminder that we require one terms notice or payment in lieu on all classes. Our terms and conditions are available on our website and when enrolling into JACAD you have to acknowledge this has been read before enrolment takes place! Please note that the notice period covers term time and requires 11 weeks notice, therefore intended departure requires notice to be given one full term prior. Like any club, society we rely on these terms and conditions in order to keep our business running. As of September this arrangement will also include the use a third party organisation to collect fees on our behalf should any contractual obligation be breached. Should an invoice need to be passed on to our debt collection agency there will be a further 15% added on to the outstanding amount owed.

Payments

Invoices are given out at the end of every term and are due for payment at the beginning of every NEW Term. Late payments will incur a 0% late charge. If you do not receive an invoice please email me.

<u>Summer Camp - August 26th to 28th</u>

We are planning on holding a Dance/Singing/Drama Summer Camp for 13yrs and under in August. Age groups include 5-7yrs, 8-10yrs and 11-13yrs. This will be a wonderful 3 days of hard work but lots of fun! Classes will be held in Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Musical Theatre, and Drama. We will offer crafts, make up tuition and games, plus a sleepover on Thursday 27th August combined with a talent competition. Please let us know if you would like your daughter/son to attend! 

Uniform

Just a reminder that all long hair should be tied back and in a bun for Ballet! We have a uniform JACAD ribbon which is currently out of stock – we will advise availability as soon as we have stock!

Our uniform supplier is Dancia in Crowthorne High Street and they are very helpful so anybody needing any uniform please pop in to the shop. Please be advised that Modern and Tap uniform from Grade 3 to Grade 6 is navy blue NOT BLACK. Also, hair needs to be securely tied back off from the face. This needs to become part of the routine for getting ready for a dance class from a young age, so parents please send your little ones to class neat and tidy.

Could my older pupils please remember to set a good example to the younger pupils. If anyone has hair too short for a bun or ponytail, then a hair band might be appropriate to keep hair off the face. If time is too limited for hair to be done before coming to the hall, then please ensure you keep in your dance bag a hairbrush, bun nets, bun pins and grips together with some spray so that you can still be neat and tidy for class. I will be issuing a directive to all of my teachers so that any pupil who does not have their hair properly tied back will be asked to do their hair before entering the class - hopefully the pupils will already come prepared and the teachers won't have to ask!

On some evenings/days I do realise that many of you attend multiple classes and that time/practicality does not permit changing from the various uniforms and I do not expect you to do so. However, as I have said previously, the modern leotard should not be worn for a ballet class and ballet tights should be worn for ALL ballet classes – not black tights.
