Communication

Coronavirus/Covid-19

We have successfully returned to the studio this term since government guidelines have allowed. I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for abiding by our coronavirus guidelines (these are available on our website) and participating in temperature checks, sanitisation procedures and wearing masks wherever possible. A reminder once again that parents cannot enter the building before/after/during classes and we ask that everyone continue to socially distance when waiting for pick up and drop off. We have also implemented contingency plans in the event of any pupils or teachers having to isolate. You can view these Covid contingency plans in full on our website, but a reminder to please inform JACAD immediately if pupils or any family members are isolating/have tested positive/are exhibiting symptoms so that we can continue to keep our JACAD community safe.

JACAD Show

As most of you will be aware there are currently a number of issues related to the pandemic affecting live performance venues and preventing theatres from operating as normal. Although I had hoped we would still be able to go ahead with our April 2021 show as planned, the situation is still very much up in the air as to whether we would be able to access South Hill Park and put on a production, and therefore we have sadly taken the very difficult decision to postpone the show until later in 2021. Those of you who have been involved in one of our productions before will know just how much work goes into them. Choreographing a show – which would consist of mostly group numbers – would be almost impossible while adhering to social distancing guidelines. We also have to consider the safety of pupils and chaperones backstage, and with the minimal space available to us, social distancing would once again be almost impossible. Finally, limitations on audience numbers would leave us unable to fully recoup costs. This has left us with no alternative but to postpone. There is nothing like the magic of a live performance, from the energy of the dancers to the fabulous lighting and music, and every show generates fantastic memories for all involved, so we are deeply saddened to have come to this decision. However, we can't wait to be in a position to put on a production as soon as we are able to - stay tuned.

Examinations

Due to social distancing regulations and the various coronavirus guidelines affecting the dance industry, both the RAD and the ISTD have amended normal operating procedures for examinations. Although the ISTD is conducting live examinations, we are only permitted to hold these in Pinewood Hall as opposed to our studio due to space. As Pinewood is a shared facility, hall availability is limited and the logistics of planning extra classes and the exams themselves is therefore difficult. The RAD is offering video examinations, although again there is the challenge of running extra classes within our timetable and in line with social distancing guidelines. We are currently working within these restrictions to see what examinations will be viable this term and next and assure pupils we are doing everything we can to offer exam opportunities for those who are ready.

<u>Fees</u>

Term fees are normally revised/increased annually in September, but as you may remember I made the decision not to implement any fee increases for 2020. Our hall hire fees have increased and in line with this our fees will be adjusted slightly from January 2021. Please review the table on the next page for your information.
