Progressive Ballet Technique (PBT)

We are delighted to finally bring this wonderful addition to our timetable from September. This class will help strength and technique enormously. The class is designed for the child who wants to improve their classical technique, which in turn will help all subjects! We will add two weekly classes to the timetable:

- PBT 2 for ages 7-12 yrs. This class will focus on turnout, extensions and core strength.
- PBT 1 for ages 12 yrs to seniors. This class will be a little more demanding and target the areas needed for improvement.


